


Visual Story The Lore of LOVERBOY Relaxed Session

The event is free but requires a ticket, please book one via the Somerset House website before your visit.


You will receive a PDF ticket which has a QR code that we will ask to scan when you enter.


Monday 5th August 18:30 - 20:00

The event takes place between 18:30 - 20:00, last entry is 30mins before the end of the event at 19:30.

We advise you arrive via the Strand entrance (pictured here), you will need to go into the courtyard by going in through the arches.

The exhibition is in the South Wing in the Terrace Rooms.



To enter the South Wing, cross the courtyard and go through the central grey doors which are circled in this photo.

There is a step-free ramp access in the same area on the doors to the left.



This is the entry door to the South Wing.



Step free route: Ramp access via the Stamp Stair door.



Step free route: Go along this corridor and turn right.



Step free route: Seamen's Hall is located at the end of this corridor.



The next room is called Seaman's Hall, you will find the entrance to the exhibition there.



The exhibition entrance is located in the Terrace Rooms which you can access from Seamen's Hall.



Along the corridor, just past Cafe Petiole are the toilets, at the end of the corridor there is an accessible toilet (circled).



There is also another accessible toilet at the end of the other corridor, next to The Lore of LOVERBOY exhibition shop (circled).



Somerset House Visitor
Experience Assistants will be available to help with any questions on the day.
Staff will be wearing purple t-shirts.



Access packs will be available from The Lore of LOVERBOY exhibition entrance.

These contain noise cancelling headphones, magnifying glass sheet for reading any printed text, a large print guide and a stress ball.



There will be a quiet space available, it is located in the corridor next to The Lore of LOVERBOY exhibition, next to the lift, the door will be open during the event.
